



## CONFIRMATION LETTER of INTENTION

Preparation for the Sacrament of Confirmation involves many projects that take time and talents to help us grow closer to God during the journey. Each corporal or spiritual work of mercy you do and each time you go deeper into understanding your Catholic faith, you show your readiness to receive this Sacrament. You are becoming stronger in your faith and ready to defend it. Jesus promises us this power and strength to go out and make disciples of all nations. For us it may be a family member, a friend, or a neighbor. Let them see your conversion of heart and your joy in receiving this Sacrament.

Please take this time to write a letter to Fr. Tim responding to these important questions regarding you and your faith journey so far and your intent to receive the Sacrament of Confirmation.

This letter must be a minimum of 1 page, typed in letter format, and printed out. Do not email the letter. Make sure your full name and what school you attend is on the top right corner. Print it out, place it in an envelope with Fr. Tim's name on it. These letters will be returned to you in your Confirmation Certificate envelope the day of Confirmation.

Questions to respond to:

-  Why do you want to be Confirmed?
-  What gifts of the Holy Spirit do you feel you are in need of and what gifts do you find effect you the most?
-  What Confirmation Name (Saint Name) have you chosen and why? Things to ponder while answering this question: what about this saint has attracted you to him/her? And, how would you like them to walk with you after Confirmation?
-  Who is your sponsor and why have you chosen him/her to walk with you?
-  What gifts and talents can you offer in serving the church once you have been confirmed?
